Responsibilities

The general supervision of all work related to the construction, operation, and maintenance of the Cooperative system including distribution, transmission, and substations.

- Prepare work plans in conjunction with the Manager, Operations Manager, and Consulting Engineering.
- Engineer work plan projects in conjunction with the engineering staff.
- Stake lines when required.
- Prepare staking engineering studies as required.
- Supervise and direct the Engineering staff, Operations Administrator, and Material Person.
- Assist the Operations Manager in preparing an annual operations budget.
- Assist in bidding work with contractors on work plan and other related jobs.
- Assist in supervision of all contractors working on the Cooperative system.
- Assist in systemic work order inspections to maintain adherence to RUS construction standards.
- Assist in the training of employees in the proper method and techniques of construction and system maintenance.
- Supervise as directed all line personnel in their specific job tasks.
- Assist in reviewing and enforcing all Cooperative policies and procedures.
- Evaluate all line personnel as directed and make suggestions as to promotions, demotions, or terminations to the Manager and Operations Manager in accordance with the Cooperative policies and procedures.
- Inspect completed work as directed to determine adherence to specifications and the quality of workmanship.
- Report immediately, to the Operation Manager on inferior work observed.
- Enforce all safety rules, policies, and procedures adapted by the Cooperative and inform the Manager and Operations Manager of violations observed.
- Attend and participate in all group or department meeting as required or requested.
- Receive trouble calls and take necessary steps for restoration of service to the members.
- As requested, investigate member complaints and take appropriate action.
- Review staking sheets and pick lists for accuracy.
- Review monthly reports of the engineering staff.
- Insure the accuracy of the mapping.
- Assist in scheduling work plan and other large related projects.
- Review upcoming inventory needs with the Material person.
- Prepare monthly activity reports for the Operations Manager.
- Provide any other services or duties as required or assigned.
